


Have you started your **2016 Guild Block of the Month** yet? There's still time!

SHARING OUR SKILLS (SOS)

Help SOS Help Habitat For Humanity

We have been advised that Habitat For Humanity will be turning the keys over to 8 families, to their new homes, this year. SOS tries to provide a full size quilt to the parent(s), and a twin size quilt to each child. They have preliminarily told us that for the first three homes, in addition to the three parent(s) there are 14 children in the three families. The children range in age from 18 down to 5.

We continue to work on the 40 quilts needed for Linn County Daycare; 20 each, boys and girls. In addition, we continue to need, on an ongoing basis, doll quilts for HACAP. Your leftover pieces of bindings will be accepted on an ongoing basis, and be made into treasured quilts, to give hugs and warmth to the people we help, who have found themselves in need.

We thank you for all the quilt tops, completed quilts, and quilts finished by machine quilting. Please know that the heart rendering facial expressions on the recipients, are due to your hard efforts. In addition to supplying quilts this last month to the Abbe Center, the Veterans Hospital, St Luke's Hospice, and a Congolese family, SOS provided Families Helping Families, a multitude of 5 and 6.5 inch squares of fabric, for their Quilt-a-thin, earlier this month. This group, whose Executive Director, Amy Jellison, is a guild member/EIHQ assistant treasurer, provides clothing, quilts, and more, to families who take in children going into foster care. They serve Linn, and the surrounding counties. In a recent year **2000** children were taken into foster care in their area. They need baby quilts thru twin, or larger, quilts, for these kids.

SOS will meet next on March 16, at Guaranty Bank, Highway 151, Fairfax, from 9:30 till about 3:30. We sew, tie, and cut fabric for all our recipients, while feasting on our potluck lunch, and solving all the problems of the world. Come for part, or all of the day, whatever fits your schedule.

6. ALL of the quilts will be awarded to Veterans in our upcoming Presentations.

NOTE: If you have a quilt for the challenge, please get a QOV label from me. Call me and I'll bring it to the next meeting.

A reminder: Thursday evening during the Quilt Show, Jim Simons (from Quilter's Rule), Ralph Osenbaugh (our QOV Area Coordinator) and I will be awarding quilts to 18 Veterans at 6:00 (before the auction).

Not just for the QOV Challenge, but for our unending challenge of awarding QOV's to Vets, I want to encourage any and all of you to help. We can use sewers of all abilities. If you make a top, we will get it quilted for you. If you are a Longarmer, perhaps you'd quilt a top for us. 


Volunteers for the MQS® and EIHQ quilt show
