February 25 – Laura Wasilowski. Create a little house quilt and receive a degree in Architecture from the Chicago

School of Fusing at the same time! In this workshop we explore the many techniques of fusing: free cutting, layering collage building, improvisational design, and more. The result is a whimsical neighborhood placed in a colorful landscape setting and made from beautifully hand-dyed fabrics. (no sewing machine required).

March 25 – Ilene Bartos. Using Ilene's pattern "Cracked Boxes" the class focuses on choosing color combinations and easy sewing techniques. Fun for all quilters, and the top can mostly be completed in the class. The pattern can be purchased ahead of time or you can purchase before the workshop. There are hand-dyed fabric kits available which include the pattern or you can bring your own fabrics.

Tuesday, May 28 – Dawn Heese, Needle Turn Applique. Small project where we practice cutting, layout and needle-turn (no sewing machine required).

Wednesday, May 29 – Dawn Heese (9-4). Quilt size can be 67 1/2" x 67 1/2". This medallion is easy enough for a beginner but interesting enough for a more experienced quilter. Folk art applique combines with easy piecing. The dogtooth border is made using a simple applique technique. All templates are full size.

June 23 – Lisa Bongean (9-4). The workshop will cover all the basics of working with wool using fusible web, threads, embroidery stitches and finishing techniques. (no sewing machine required)

August 26 - Ruth Green (noon to 5). Learn tricks and techniques for making a stunning wall-hanging that looks like a stained glass window from Ruth of Green Glass Designs. This appears complicated but is actually suitable for beginners. We will learn how easy this technique can be using black bias and twin needles in your sewing machine.

Thursday, September 19 – Jamie Wallen, Mystical Feathers 2, The Next Evolution. This Feathers Class takes the frond and spine to the next level. Join Jamie as he teaches advanced Blocks, Sashes, Borders and more. He will also show you the new evolution in Feathers. Be prepared to leave your comfort zone and evolve with quilting's best loved motif. This class applies to all levels of Long-arm, Mid-arm, Short-arm or Hand Quilters. Lecture presentation. You will learn a myriad of designs using these elements for your Customer and personal surface quilting and apply them to Edge to Edge, Customized Blocks, Borders and Sash Designs to speed up your earning potential while making your surface quilting stand above the rest.
