

Layout Time – Yippie!

I hope you held out this long and you are ready to put your garden together.

This quilt is laid out on the diagonal. You will start in the top left corner with a floral rectangle and build down from there. The pinwheels will be on point and they are the block that goes straight up and down through the quilt top, so your brick will be at an angle.

Your edge will zig zag across, we will clean them up after the center is pieced.

Clear as mud? How about a picture or two to help?



The rows alternate a floral with a pieced brick. On the edges you will add the necessary cropped brick or finishing edge brick. Now in a few places you will need to add the 4 patch triangles that you have left.



Floral and a 4 patch triangle.

Floral and a Cropped Brick.

Floral, full brick, floral.

Floral, brick, floral, and a Finishing edge brick. Top of pinwheel row.

Floral, brick, floral, brick, floral.

And onward! Remember pinwheels go straight down your quilt.

This is mine in layout mode, that is why there is a gap in the middle.
Our flower garden needs its border!
