

Now we make our Blue Sky!

You survived the 4 patch path and don't hyper-ventilate when I tell you what you need for the sky. After you are done with this block it is all easy piecing. I promise!

Cut 2" strips from your blue and white scraps or fat quarters.

I did use the same white with a blue dot throughout the whole quilt. But my blues are scrappy!

Take one white strip and one blue strip, right sides together. I put the white strip on the bottom. Use the Easy Angle ruler and cut at the 2" mark. Just like you did for the half four patch triangles.

This will make triangle pairs and they are ready to sew! Don't take them apart.

Remember to scrap up those blues! I put them in stacks of 10 and take several stacks to the sewing machine at a time. I sew across the angle and this makes a square half white and half blue. You will need (gasp) 388 of these little units.

Finger press your seams to the dark and trim off those little dog ears now. You will be glad you did. Put four together to make a pinwheel. All your pinwheels need to spin the same way – very important!

You need to make 96 pinwheels.
