President's Challenge- March 2024
Here's a NEW block for you to make and bring back for March's meeting: New Mexico. It can be two colors, three colors or scrappy. It will be $151 / 2$ " square.

Step 1: You will need 12 half squares that are $31 / 2 "$ square. Use any method you like, but here's the traditional method.

- Cut two $43 / 8$ " squares (one background and one color).
- Cut on the diagonal of each square.
- Put two triangles right sides together. Sew $1 / 4$ " on the long side.
- Press the seam to the dark side. Trim to $31 / 2 "$ square. Repeat.

Step 2: Nine Patches - You will create four nine patches that will measure $31 / 2$ " square. Use any method you like, but here's the traditional method.

- Cut five $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " colored squares. Cut four $11 / 2 "$ background squares.
- Sew together rows:
- color, background, color
- Background, color, background
- Color, background, color
- Sew the rows together. Trim to $31 / 2$ ".

Step 3: Strip blocks- You will create four strip blocks that will measure $31 / 2$ " square.

- Cut eight background strips measuring $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times 31 / 2$ ". Cut four color strips $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2$ ".
- Sew a background strip to a color strip. Press, seam to color side.
- Sew a background strip to the other side of the color strip. Press, seam to the color side.

Step 4: Cut five $3 ½$ " color squares.
Assemble as shown.
