



**WHAT IS A  
ROUND  
ROBIN QUILT?**

A round robin quilt is one that is created by a group of quilters. This style of group challenge became popular about 20 years ago and comes and goes in popularity. The size of the group is usually five or six members (anything larger can make an unbelievably large quilt!)

# How does it work?

Each member of the group creates a center of a particular size. The center block gets passed to the next person who adds a border to it. It then is passed to the next person until each member of the group has put a border on the quilt. When it is completed, it is returned to the original creator.

Some groups include a journal with ideas about the block and each member writes about their border. Some include a box of coordinating fabrics with the understanding that each border will contain some of that fabric (and additional fabric from that piecer).
